*Approval of Minutes - December 2, 2024, FCWD Consortium Meeting

*Acceptance of the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Annual Audit

Mr. Morgan's biography and nomination letter was reviewed. Motion to approve the appointment for the new Board of Director member made by Commissioner Renninger and seconded by Commissioner Hartley. *Operations Update

- The December 2024 Employment Statistics were presented. The unemployment rate is down slightly at 3.0% from 3.5% last month. We have seen an increase in job seekers in our centers with a total of 5,174. This is the highest number to date since January and higher than in the last two years. Our Gateway and Southside locations saw the biggest jump, but the increase is across our entire region.
- We have seen job orders substantially decrease in the last year. These numbers are reflective in other regions as well. The number of jobs at Indeed.com is down as well. Job order trends by industry were reviewed.
